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Report: how students in the USA spend their average weekday.

On a recent pursuit we have collected some information about it. The aim of this report is to present this information.

In general

For both 2014 and 2015 the most time-requiring activities for American students have been sleeping, leisure and sports, education, working and related. However, there was a tendency to decrease the time spent on sleeping, educational activities and others in favour of sports, leisure and traveling.

Comparing the years

As we can see from the charts, some changes took place. In 2014 sleeping took 8.6 hours a day, but in 2015 it took 4.1 hours a day. Time spent on other things dramatically fell from 2.3 hours a day to only 0.5. Leisure and sports' time rose from 3.8 to 5.6 hours a day. Traveling time increased from 1.5 to 2.9 hours per day. Time required for eating and drinking doubled: in 2014 it took an hour a day, in 2015 it became two hours. In 2015 students spent an hour less time on education; in 2014 it took them 3.4 hours a day, but in 2015 it took 2.4 hours a day. But the time that students spent every day on working and related activities slightly increased; from 2.2 to 3 hours.

Conclusion

To sum this up I can say that there were significant changes in how much time students in the USA spend on which activity. In comparing to 2014, in 2015 they put more attention to working, traveling, sports and leisure, and less to education, sleeping and other activities, while to grooming it remained almost the same.
