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Productive weekends,

The charts demonstrate the amount of time students spend on various activities during weekends.

From an overall perspective in 2014 the vast majority of students' time is spent on sleeping. The charts clearly show that teenagers sleep up to 8,6 hours per day. Almost four hours is wasted on leisure and sports which is unfortunately way more than educational activities that take 2,4 hours daily. Moreover, students spend three hours a day working, although the number is still pretty low due to the fact that employers usually hire students only for part-time jobs, as they may still be inexperienced and unreliable. Other activities take up to 2,3 hours, whilst less than two is spent on traveling, eating and grooming each.

Moving on to the next chart, the number of hours spent on sleeping has plummeted to 7,1 within a year. However, a striking point is that sports have gained extreme popularity among students, rising to 5,6 hours, and so did the traveling, doubling in comparison to the year before. Nevertheless, the dramatic decrease in extracurricular studying is obvious. Students may think they can always catch up learning, so spending extra time doing something so unimportant is unnecessary. Hours spent on meeting biological needs have slumped as well, whilst working now has risen to 3 hours daily.

All things considered, we clearly see the complete reassessment of values. Students are more likely to give up sleeping and to do necessary activities. Within a year, the amount of studying time has decreased, so sports took the leading role in hobbies and traveling became more relevant than ever.
